General Information

Through the child sponsorship program a sponsor provides support for a child living with his or her own family and within their own native community. This program tailors the support for each child according to their individual needs. The basic necessities such as food, clothing, education and medical attention are provided for each child. However we also work on structural solutions to poverty. An important element of child sponsorship involves working on ways to improve the standard of living for the community as a whole. Each year you will receive an updated photo and information about your sponsored child. **The cost of sponsorship is \$35 per month. Checks should be sent to: Help A Child, P.O. We encourage sponsors who do not already do so to consider setting up your monthly, quarterly or annual donations to Help A Child as an **automatic or recurring check payment** with your bank. This will result in a more regular and dependable flow of support for Help A Child. The checks can be sent in any frequency desired. Most banks don't charge anything for the service. For those sponsors who prefer instead to continue sending a regular check, please feel free to do so.

These often get lost or stolen, and the recipient may be charged import taxes. If you send anything directly it should be able to fit in a flat envelope, such as photos, stickers, etc.

Hundreds of thousands of children and youth have reaped the fruits of our work. How we went about our work in 2016 is set out in this annual report.

Our work continues. The challenges are immense. The abolition of the co-financing system at the end of 2015 took a toll on our resources in 2016. The resulting gap in our funding has not yet been closed, but we have good hope that we will manage to do this in the coming period.

We are grateful for the support and encouragement from our loyal supporters. They too form part of the Help a Child family. Our sponsors are committed and keep us focused. And, as ever, we know that our work is dependent on God's blessing.
